Thanks for protecting your pet with a microchip! This animal care organization is going to link your email address and other contact info to the chip in the free **Found Animals Registry!** *If you don't use email, ask a friend or family member if you can use theirs to register your pet.*

What you'll need to do:

- **Look out for a welcome email** from the Found Animals Registry - you'll use it to log in to your account and confirm that the info sent to us was entered correctly (typos *are* common!).
- **Keep your registration up-to-date** so that we can reach you via calls, texts, and emails if your pet is ever lost and found.
- Visit **found.org/resources** for instructions on updating your info, adding pets, and much more (it's *a/ways* free!).
- Keep your pet's **microchip card** in your wallet or with their other medical/adoption paperwork in a safe place.

If you don't get a welcome email from us within a week, first check your spam folder, and then visit www.found.org and click "Contact Us" for help.
